<b>Title of Project</b>	<b>Hygiene and sanitation promotion at Woreda 01 of Kolfe Keraniy Sub-City</b>

<b>Project Summary</b>	<p>More than 33,300 inhabitants of Woreda 01, Kolfe Keraniyo Sub-City of Addis Ababa are suffering from poor hygiene and sanitation conditions. Proximity of Qoshe, the biggest solid waste landfill site of Addis Ababa is the major causes of multitude of health problems of the nearby residents. Poor access to water and sanitation services and low awareness of the inhabitants about pollutants, disease causing agents and preventive measures aggravated the problem. Situations are worse especially in the two squatter settlements namely <b>Agew Sefer and Gonder Sefer</b>. According to the Kolfe Keraniyo subcity Bureau of Health more than 95% of the households in these areas do not have latrines.</p> <p>The two public schools in the neighborhood <b>Abune Basilios</b> and <b>Biruh Tesfa (formerly known as Zenebework)</b> and their 6500 students, teachers and staff are also victims of the health issues arising from Qoshe. Shortage of clean water is another major problem making the school community vulnerable to a host of communicable disease.</p> <p>The project funded by the Ethiopian Diaspora Trust Fund (EDTF) in collaboration with government partners, the community and the two schools will build water and sanitation infrastructure to alleviate the problem. It will also implement module-based health, hygiene and sanitation education to beneficiaries to sustain project outputs and results.</p>
<b>Project Objective:</b>	By increasing access to water and sanitation (WASH) services and awareness the project will improve the hygiene, sanitation and health condition of the community living close to the Addis Ababa solid waste landfill commonly known as Qoshe.
<b>Main Activities:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Construct WASH infrastructures, including 15 communal latrines with access to water and wash facilities.</li> <li>▪ Construct separate latrines for girls and boys with clean water scheme in Abune Basilios and Biruh Tesfa (Zenebework) Public Schools.</li> <li>▪ Provide successive and modular health education on environmental sanitation; clean home management; hygienic food preparation &amp; preservation; handwashing technics etc in compliance with the Addis Ababa health extension packages.</li> </ul>
